Michael Coren is helping us with a new program to encourage engagement, companionship and reduce isolation with our neighbours at the Dorval complex.

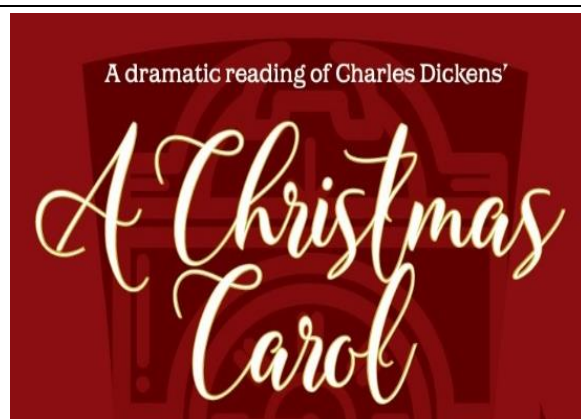

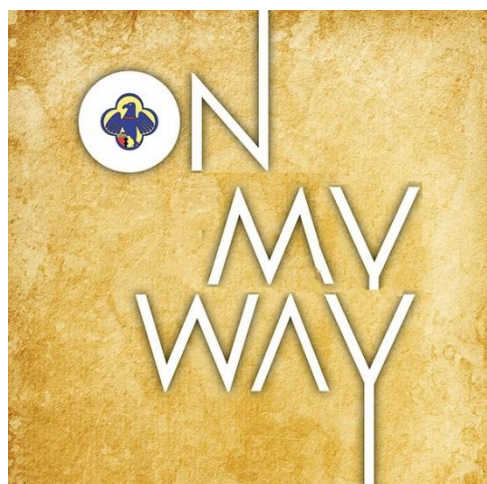
### Once was nice, let's do it twice!
