She is currently ministering at Trinity -St. Pauls on Bloor Street in Toronto. Cheri will share with us how her spirituality has developed and shaped her personal and public life. 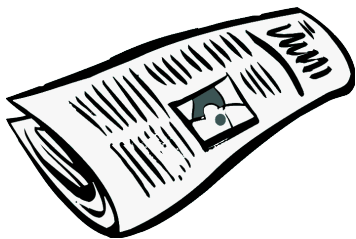


Incarnation Choir Rehearsals Wednesdays at 7:15
