**Geothermal Ribbon Cutting Ceremony**

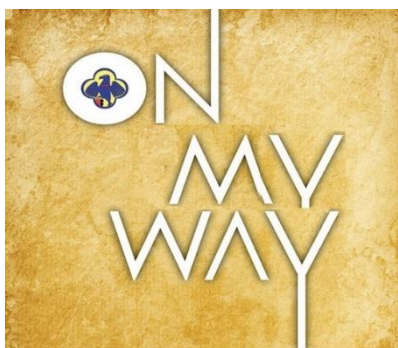
Friday, February 22, 10:30-11:30 at Incarnation

**TED McMEEKIN Thursday Feb 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm**

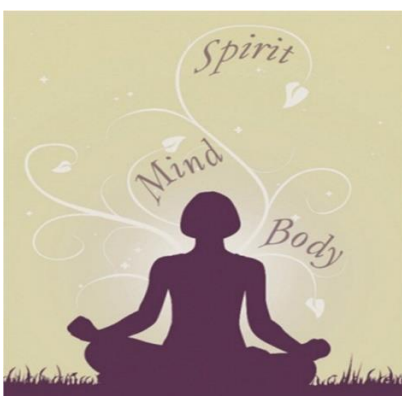

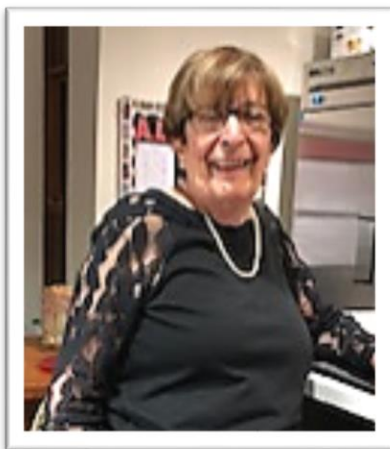


### Milk Bag Collection
