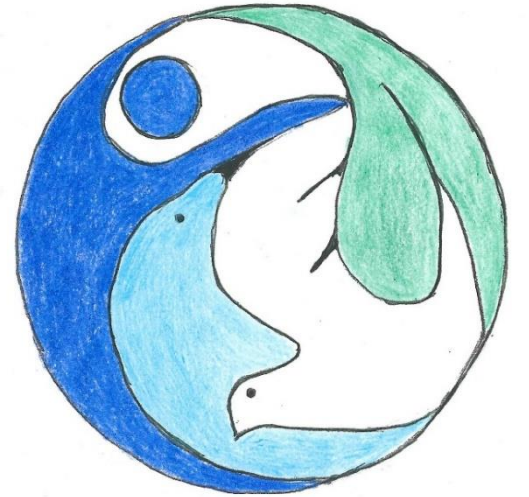


February 2: One Among the Beings Called to Pay Attention

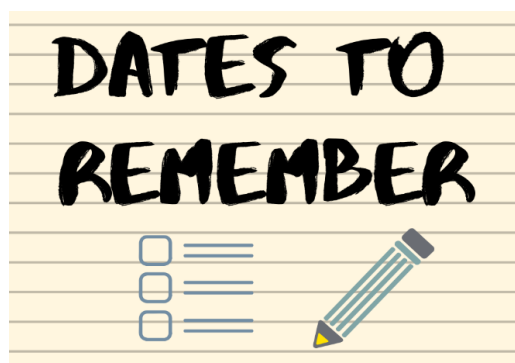

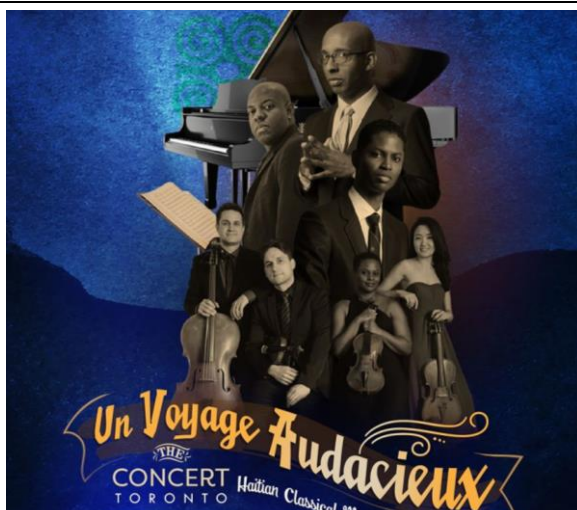

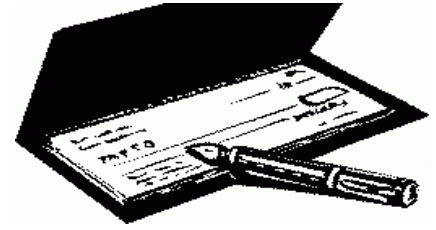
